Types and Criteria for the Dream Project

- Dream Project targets at small-scale projects which should be completed within the same academic year, and which should be based in Hong Kong.
- The proposed project should be in line with the school motto, namely, “Understanding Truth”, “Pursuing God”, “Developing Diligence”, and “Cultivating Virtue”.
- Individual students or groups up to five people are welcome to apply for the project. For group applicants, they have to assign a member as the contact person.
- Student applicant(s) should invite a teacher to be the project advisor, who cannot be one of the judges. But it is stipulated that the project be completed by the students themselves on their own initiatives.
- The advisor only needs to give opinion, but is not obliged to monitor the progress of the project.
- Student applicant(s) should specify the objectives and goals of the proposed project, the beneficiary and expected outcome which may be in the form of a performance, service provision or any real product. A budget should also be included.
- Successful applicants are obliged to submit 3 interim reports to the Student Achievement Committee for evaluation of the progress of the project.
- Individual student or the person-in-charge of the short-listed proposal will be interviewed by the selection committee.
- Evidence should be provided upon the completion of the project. Student applicant(s) should submit a report and they are obliged to present their project with the other people in different occasions. Their project will be demonstrated in an exhibition.

Application Procedure

- The awarded projects are expected to be conducted from December 2019 to July 2020.
- A panel of judges will be established to review the project applications, which encompasses Dr. Cheng, Mr Lee Chun Fai Tompson, a parent representative, and the Student Council Chairperson.
- The student applicants will be shortlisted to have an interview with the panel of judges.
- Normally the school will consider granting 50%-100% subsidy on a case-by-case basis, with the amount capped at HKD\$5000. The amount of subsidy will be granted at the discretion of the school authority.
- The subsidy will be granted by installments, and will be based on the budget plan and the progress.
- An agreement as for the granting of the project will be signed between the school, and the students as well as their parents.
- Successful applicant(s) may be required to refund the school if the project is not fully implemented without reasonable explanation.
- The school authority reserves the ultimate right in the decision for the grant.
- No more than 8 projects will be approved in a year.
- The unsuccessful applicants may be asked to revise their proposal for further consideration.
